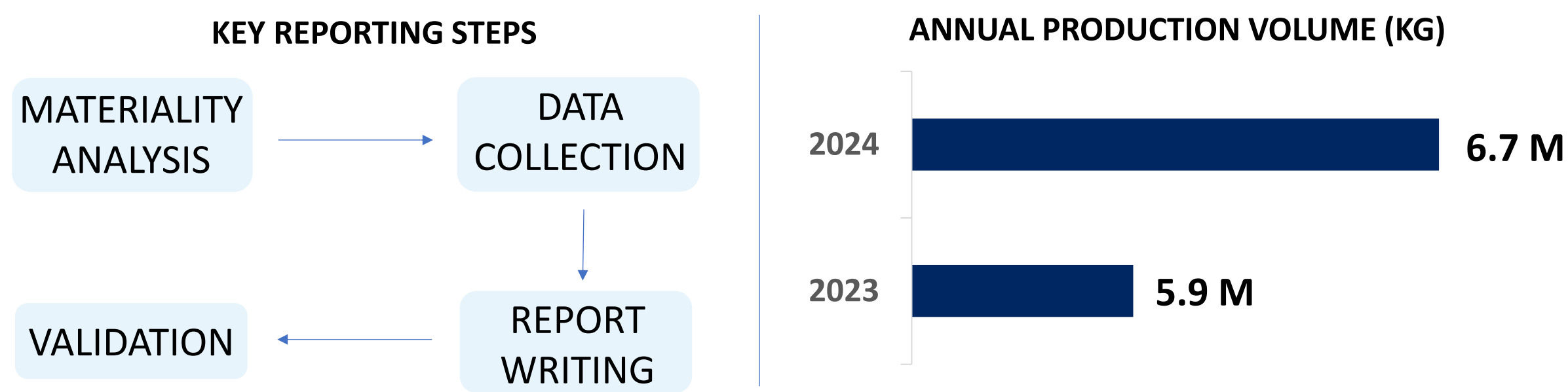


THE NEW CORICHEM SUSTAINABILITY REPORT BASED ON THE EUROPEAN CSRD

Corichem is not currently subject to any regulatory obligation regarding non-financial reporting – not exceeding the size thresholds set by EU Directive 2022/2464 (CSRD), implemented in Italy through Legislative Decree 125/2024 – the preparation of Sustainability reports therefore occurs on a voluntary basis.



Corichem's materiality analysis is based on the principle of double materiality, which considers two key dimensions of sustainability:

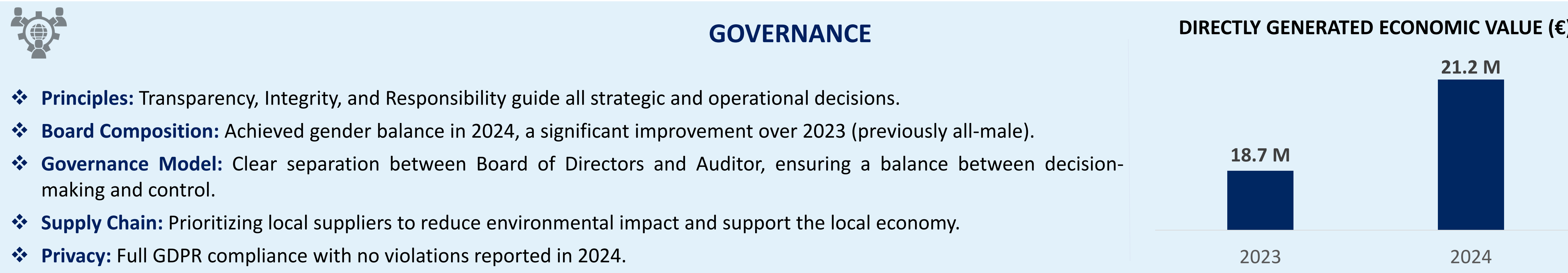
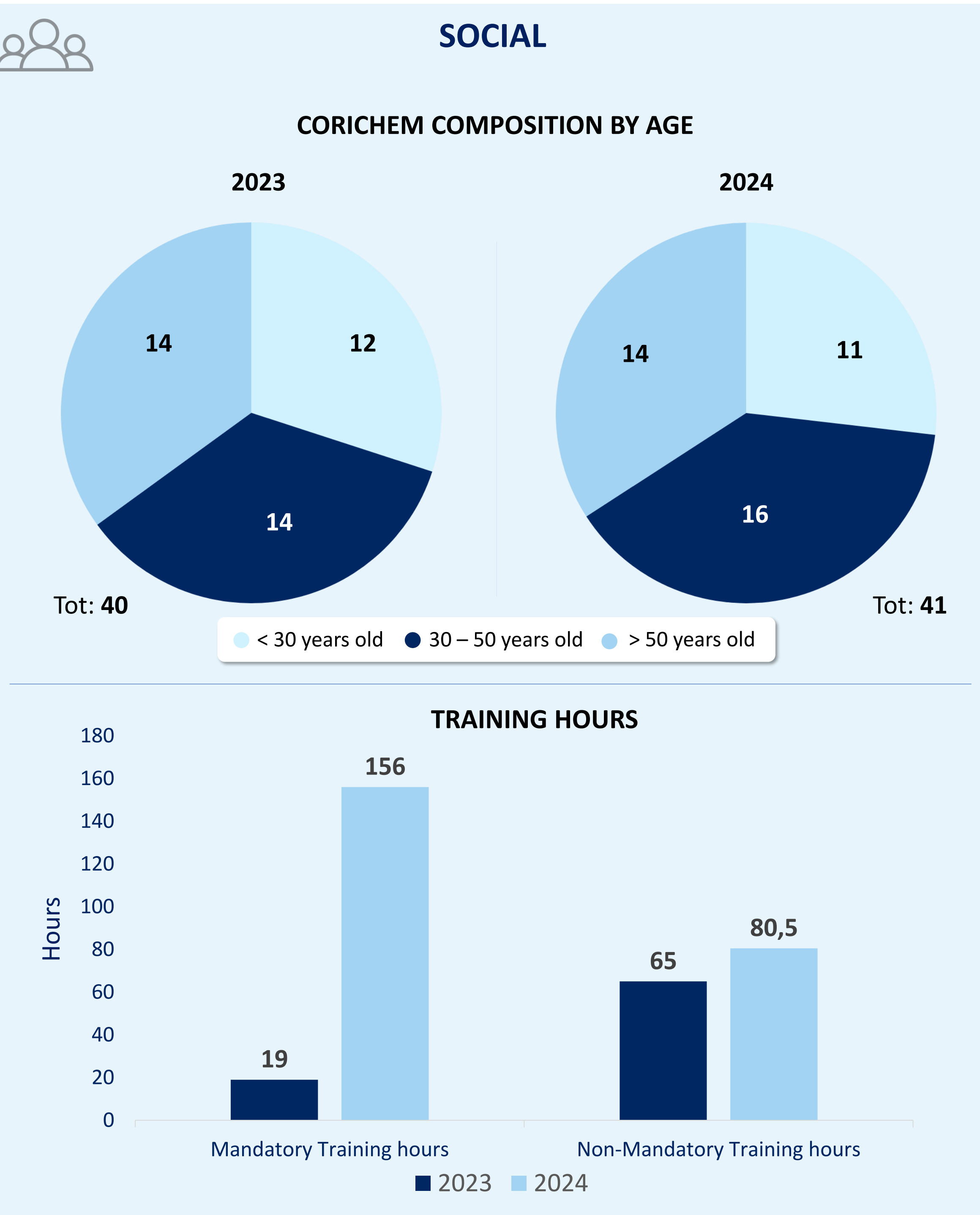
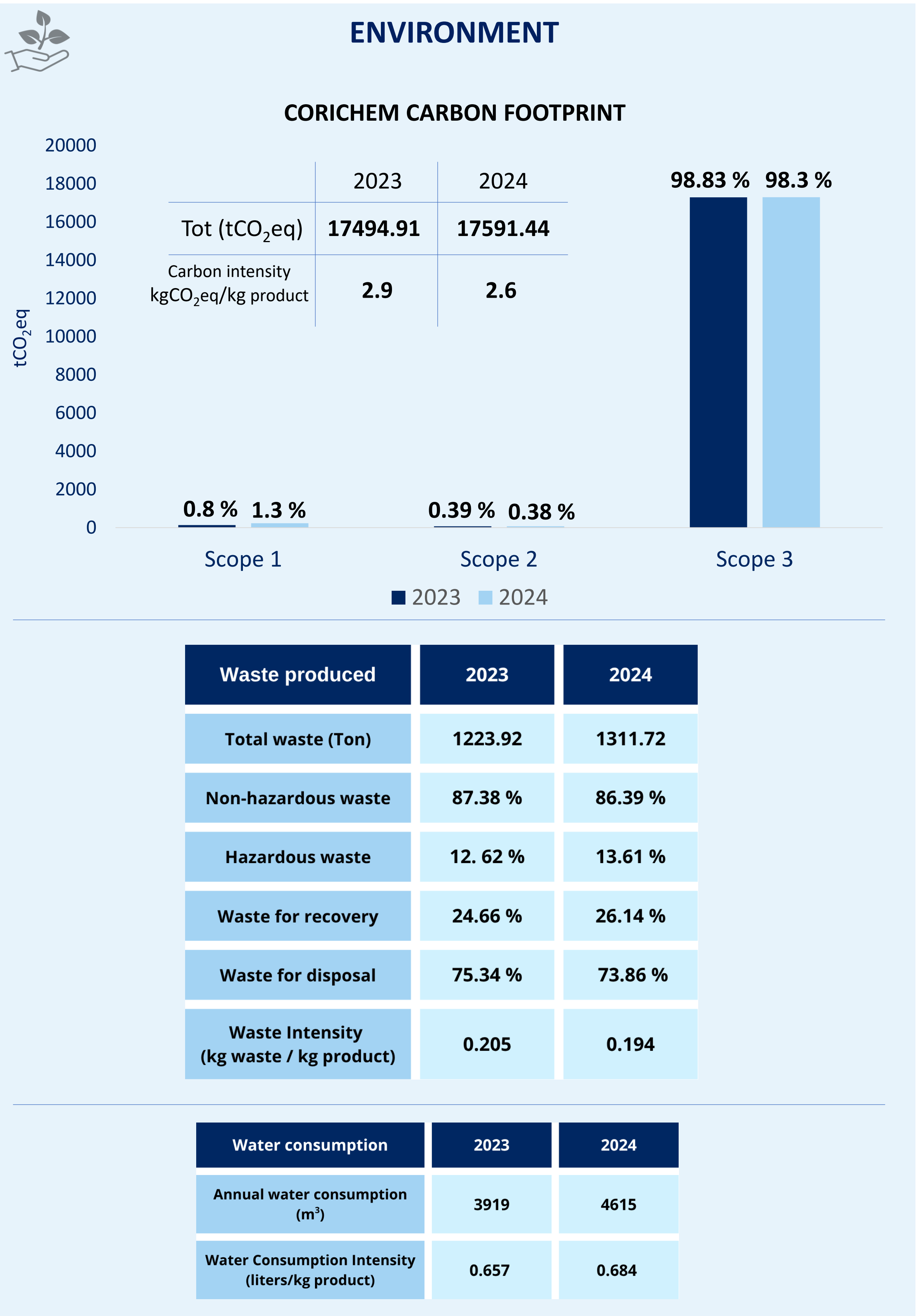
1. Impact Materiality

2. Financial Materiality

In the 2023 Sustainability Report, Corichem defined its impact materiality matrix through active stakeholder involvement.

In 2024, the analysis was updated to reflect changes in the operational context, with no need for a complete revision. Regarding financial materiality, a scientific approach was adopted to identify climate-related risks and opportunities, using a quantitative model based on ESRS standards. Material issues were determined through a rating system that actively involved the company's management.

CONCLUSION AND FUTURE COMMITMENTS

Despite a slight increase in carbon footprint, waste, and water consumption in 2024, primarily due to higher production volumes, Corichem has made progress in key social and governance areas. The growth in directly generated economic value reflects both operational expansion and responsible management. Future sustainability efforts will focus on installing photovoltaic panels, promoting bulk product sales to reduce packaging waste, and conducting LCA studies on selected products.
